CONSTITUTION BENCH TO REVIEW SCRAPPING OF ARTICLE 370 IN JAMMU AND KASHMIR, CENTER GETS SC NOTICE

A batch of petitions challenging scrapping of ARTICLE 370 that gave special status to Jammu and Kashmir will be heard by a five —judge bench of the Supreme court in early October, Chief Justice of India RANJAN GOGOI also issued the notice to the government to respond to the petition on scrapping of Article 370 as well as restriction on the media of Jammu and Kashmir.

During the hearing, the centre's top second senior law officer Tasha Mehta had requested the top court on more than one occasion not an issue a formal notice to the government.

Court's notice would have 'cross border repercussions' and was liable to be misused. Mehta also alluded to the political leader using the court notice to target the government "Anything that happened to this is projected by the other political leader," he said.

ARTICLE 370 SCRAPPED

JAMMU & KASHMIR AND THE CONSTITUTION

October 26, 1947:

Maharaja Hari Singh executes the Instrument of Accession under the Indian Independence Act acceding to the Dominion of India, which was to exercise powers only in relation to Defence, External Affairs and Communication.

October 17, 1949: Article 370 included in the Constitution making Jammu and Kashmir a part of India as one of the States under Article 1. Except Article 1 and Article 370, J&K exempted from the Constitution. For extending any central

law related to matters other than Defence, External Affairs and Communication, the concurrence

of the State Government and its further ratification by the J&K Constituent Assembly was mandatory.

July 24, 1952: Delhi
Agreement signed to
constitute a framework
for distribution of legislative power between State
and Central legislature
and extending the Constitutional jurisdiction in

the State. It gave special powers to the J&K State Legislature to make laws for conferring

special rights and privileges on its subjects and it extended Articles 52 to 62 of the Constitution to the State.

May 14, 1954: The Constitution (Application to Jammu and Kashmir) Order, 1954, issued by the President under Article 370, extended numerous Articles of the Constitution as well as the jurisdiction of the Supreme Court, Election Commission, CAG and UPSC to J&K. This Order also added Article 35A to the Constitution that empowered the State Legislature to define permanent residents of J&K and provide special rights and privileges to them.

August 5, 2019: The Government moves a resolution in Parliament to abrogate Article 370 and re-organise J&K as two distinct Union Territories – Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh.

TRIPLE TALAQ NOW A CRIME



The apex court bench on Friday issued notice to the center on a set of PIL's challenging the recent Muslim women (PROTECTION OF RIGHTS ON MARRIAGE) Act 2019, more popularly known as **triple talaq criminalization**.

- ❖ The bench asked the petitioners why an objection was being made on religious ground's.
- ❖ The bench pointed out while the act prescribes a maximum sentence of 3 years.

ISRO TO INJECT CHANDRAYAAN -2 INTO LUNAR ORBIT

After Chandrayaan-2 enters the lunar orbit, there will be further four orbit maneuvers to make the space craft enter into its final orbit passing over its lunar poles at the distance of about 100 km from the moon's surfac, ISRO has said.

In a significant milestone for India's Moon mission, Indian space research organization will fire chandrayaan-2's liquid engine on Tuesday to insert the space craft into lunar orbit.



RBI TO TRANSFER RECORD SURPLUS OF 1.76 LAKH CRORE TO GOVERNMENT

RESERVE BANK OF INDIA (RBI) board on Monday approved a record surplus transfer of 1.75 lakh crore to the government. A large part of these Rs 1.23 lakh crore was the surplus for the year and the remaining Rs 50637 crore was from surplus reserve. The transfer is based on formula recommended by the Bimal Jalan committee's revised Economic Capital Framework that was adopted by the board.



G-7 NATION'S PLEDGE \$40 MILLION TO FIGHT AMAZON FIRES

The international pledges at the G7 summit in France included \$ 20 million from the group as a well separate \$11 million from Canada.

Ottawa Al has also offered to send fire fighting planes to Brazil.

Other groups are supporting for a region whose rain forest is a major absorber of the carbon dioxide from the atmosphere. The funds are widely seen as critical support, a relatively small amount for dealing with an environment crisis.
